

Procedures for Bed Bugs

Bed bug found on child or found in the classroom:

1. If the teacher saw a bed bug on a child, the teacher sends the child and child's backpack to the healthroom.
2. Health aide will check the child for any bed bugs and check child's back pack. Healthaide would spray child's back pack with non-toxic material such melaluca product.
3. Once cleared of bed bugs, child would return to the classroom.
4. Healthaide notifies parent of bed bug finding and would give information on bed bugs to parents.
5. If found in the classroom, custodian will look at the classroom for blood stains or evidence of other existing bed bugs. If need to, custodian will disinfect classroom. If more evidence of bed bugs are found, we will call facilities management for further action.
6. If no evidence is found, we will continue to follow above procedure when seeing or informed of another bed bug.
